

CLUB GRANTS

In line with Club Burwood Group's strong dedication to and support of the local community, in excess of \$842,500 in funding has been contributed by the group to the Burwood Community in Club Grant funding for 2017.

Category 1 funding is for specific community welfare, social services, community development, health and employment assistance programs. Priorities for this year's funding were children and families, youth, culturally and linguistically diverse communities, volunteer based programs and projects that encourage active aging.

The Club Grants 1 Committee, consisting of representatives from Burwood Council, Metro Migrant Resource Centre, Inner West Neighbour Aid & Department of Family and Community considered the 61 applications received, donating to a total of 52 organisations with a total Club Grant funding of \$277,300. Homes for Heroes and One Door Mental Health received the highest donations of \$20,000 each to these very worthy causes. This, in addition to category 2 funding and in-kind funding equated to a total in excess of \$842,500 being awarded to the Community.
